He died Saturday, Oct. 28, 2000.

He was born Feb. 5, 1928, in Pampa. He graduated from high school at Denver City. He served in the U.S. Army Air Corp from 1946-1949. He held a bachelor's of science degree from Hardin-Simmons University and a master's degree from Eastern New Mexico University.

He was a member of Parkland Baptist Church in Clovis, N.M. He was past president of the Clovis Rotary Club and the Clovis Chamber of Commerce and was a member of Phi Kappa Phi Academic Honor Society. He was elected to the New Mexico Education Hall of Fame in 1986.

He retired in 1986 as superintendent of Clovis Schools following 32 years of dedicated service and positions at all levels of education in New Mexico including teacher and administrator in the Hobbs schools, superintendent of Jal schools, administrative positions with the Department of Defense Dependents' schools in Germany from 1962 to 1968 and as executive director of economic development in Clovis from 1986 to 1988.

Survivors include his wife, Betty Jo Owens Trice of Clovis; two sons, Richard Calvin of Raton, N.M., and Jeffrey David of Forth Worth; a daughter, Cheryl Kay Wills of Muleshoe; three sisters, Murrell Cooper and Kathryn Rodriguez, both of Hobbs, and Barbara Wilder of Denver City; two brothers, Ralph J. of Hobbs and Donald R. of Jal, N.M.; and six grandchildren
