We're offering flexible travel options for new ticket purchases between February 27 and March 31, 2020, for travel through February 28, 2021.

- Change or cancel your ticket and deposit the funds into My Account with no fee.

AMERICAN AIRLINES:

Book your flight with confidence: We're pleased to offer you more flexibility for your travel. When you buy a new Non-Refundable Fare ticket by March 31, 2020, we'll waive the change fee if your future travel plans change. You can make a one-time change before your original departure date*.

If you purchased a ticket on American Airlines between March 5, 2020 at 9 a.m. CT and March 31, 2020 at 11:59 p.m. CT, you may change your flight once without paying a change fee*. Tickets must be purchased for travel between March 5, 2020 and January 30, 2021.
