The "final thoughts" piece from me which is in the front of the enclosed Memory Book was written in June of 1999; it is now January of 2003. Obviously, an update is in order.

To say I have been discouraged about my ability to complete my "assignment" for the Berlin Brats is an understatement. My feelings of failure definitely lessened my passion to complete my goal and fulfill my responsibility. The uncollated copies and labeled envelopes remained in the boxes in my bedroom waiting for a Saturday opportunity at work until I married. Company policy changed, badges were issued; we were only allowed on certain floors of the building. Yada - yada!

I won't bore you with the rest of the challenges I yielded to, except to relate that I became engaged in December 1999 to the photographer, Craig Satterfield; married in 2000 (moved) and underwent a Company name change and stock symbol change; in 2001, I graduated with a 3.45 GPA; and in 2002, I lost my job and had gave two daughters their dream wedding. I am now free to complete all those "to do's" I have put off! Hurray!

Some of you are probably asking by now why I didn't enlist help. There were offers, but they came from B-Brats who lived far, far away; and the "stuff" was too disorganized to dump on someone else to sort through. Also, I had agreed to take on the cost of it and did not intend to burden the group with what I considered to be my personal responsibility based on my personal commitment.

I apologize for taking so long and fully appreciate that your perception of me is in no way improved!

My hope is that the Memory Book brings back warm thoughts of a great week end and of friendships forged.

I am sure you can appreciate the great work Jeri Polansky-Glass et al have done. When I was voted in as the reunion organizer for the 1996 reunion in 1991 (Ray Holmes in Georgia), we had 80 names and addresses. I knew that in order to find all the alumni, we would have to get organized--hence, Berlin Brats Association. By 1996, we had 800 names. Berlin Brats, today, is more than any one of us could envisioned it to be. I hope none of us take it for granted. We are very fortunate to have Jeri's leadership and dedicated volunteers who have a passion for maintaining our group. My hats off to them all! Hope you plan on attending the Asheville reunion!

Some final thoughts...

As I put the finishing touches on the Memory Book for the long ago reunion, I am aware of many emotions. First, it is good to finally finish this. Although it may seem to others that I had dismissed my commitment, to the contrary, I was always aware of my pending responsibility, the negative feelings the delay must have caused, and my own tendency toward perfectionism.

For whatever reason, you are probably surprised to be getting it. There are probably errors in the addresses. I am sure the question will arise, "Why didn't she include the entire roster?" Simply, these are the persons who were there, with the names and addresses of persons who requested that they be added to the Memory Book. I forwarded 300 copies of the roster to the Association about a month after the reunion for mailing in the newsletter they were putting together.

Let me briefly recap my odyssey: After the reunion, the first priority was to regroup. I had managed to negotiate with the reunion planner to have some of the funds he had taken in forwarded to us for the reunion--about \$1600. He had gotten us a great DJ for Friday night, I had reserved the Austin Ranch and put the deposit up, and what was left was paying for Friday, Saturday at the hotel, the photographer, and the catering. We had the suite for regular room rate, in which I was able to display all the yearbooks and trophies. A friend acted as photographer (free). Many things worked out above and beyond expectations, however, we had counted on 120 people based on a post card survey I had done the year prior, and only about 20 people showed up. (You pay the same for the rooms, the catering, the entertainment, no matter how many come.)

Jeri Polansky Glass and Renee Shipley Knowles took on the task of putting together the next reunion and the newsletter. In return, I forwarded the remaining funds (about \$900), the roster, and addressed envelopes. I agreed to do the Memory Book since I had all the photos. The last time I had done a newsletter, the black and white camera ready photos cost \$7 apiece. That had gone up to \$25. Balk! So, I decided to try to scan them at work, but discovered that our company has a strict policy against such endeavors (private use of materials). So began a long tedious journey, punctuated with failure, stirred on by love for those people I know. In the past two years, I have gone through 2 computers. I have moved. I have raised my daughter, and now look forward to becoming a Grandmother in June.

We all should be very proud of the work Jeri and Renee have done. They have garnered interest, gleaned lost souls, and gathered the group into a robust, excited collective. I hope you do not take their efforts lightly, and that you continue to support their efforts. Mostly, if you say you are going to do it, do it. While I may not be the best example of "doing it", I am an example of what happens when others (me included) don't.

Finally, I want to leave you with my thoughts and my heart. Berlin, the city, is so special. We all know that. We all appreciate it, and rejoice in our privilege to have lived there. This unites us. We are also united by a common culture--the fortress. The fortress has its own values, adaptations, and structure. We understand it, and function in the "real world" more fully because of what we learned in it. I did not understand that until I volunteered to do the 1996 reunion. Until then, I was isolated, misunderstood, and frustrated with my rootlessness. Now, I know what my roots are, and appreciate them greatly. I consider the Berlin Brats Associates my home. I have left home, and so have you all. But, it is good to know there is a place, and a group, and a society, that we belong to. I trust you share that sense of 'home'.


