The occupants of the house include the young and lovely heiress, Ellen Clayton, currently confined to a wheelchair; her coolly beautiful stepmother, Karen, and the austere housekeeper, Jenny. Into their midst arrives Nurse Pepper, cheerful, curious and with a desire to put things in order. Also new to the scene is substitute doctor, Corey Phillips, who sees no reason Ellen shouldn't walk again--and soon. The adventure and comedy start with a sudden and violent murder and carry through to a chilling and surprising climax. There are sliding doors, secret stairways, an underground tunnel and a man apparently from the water below to baffle the occupants of the house.
