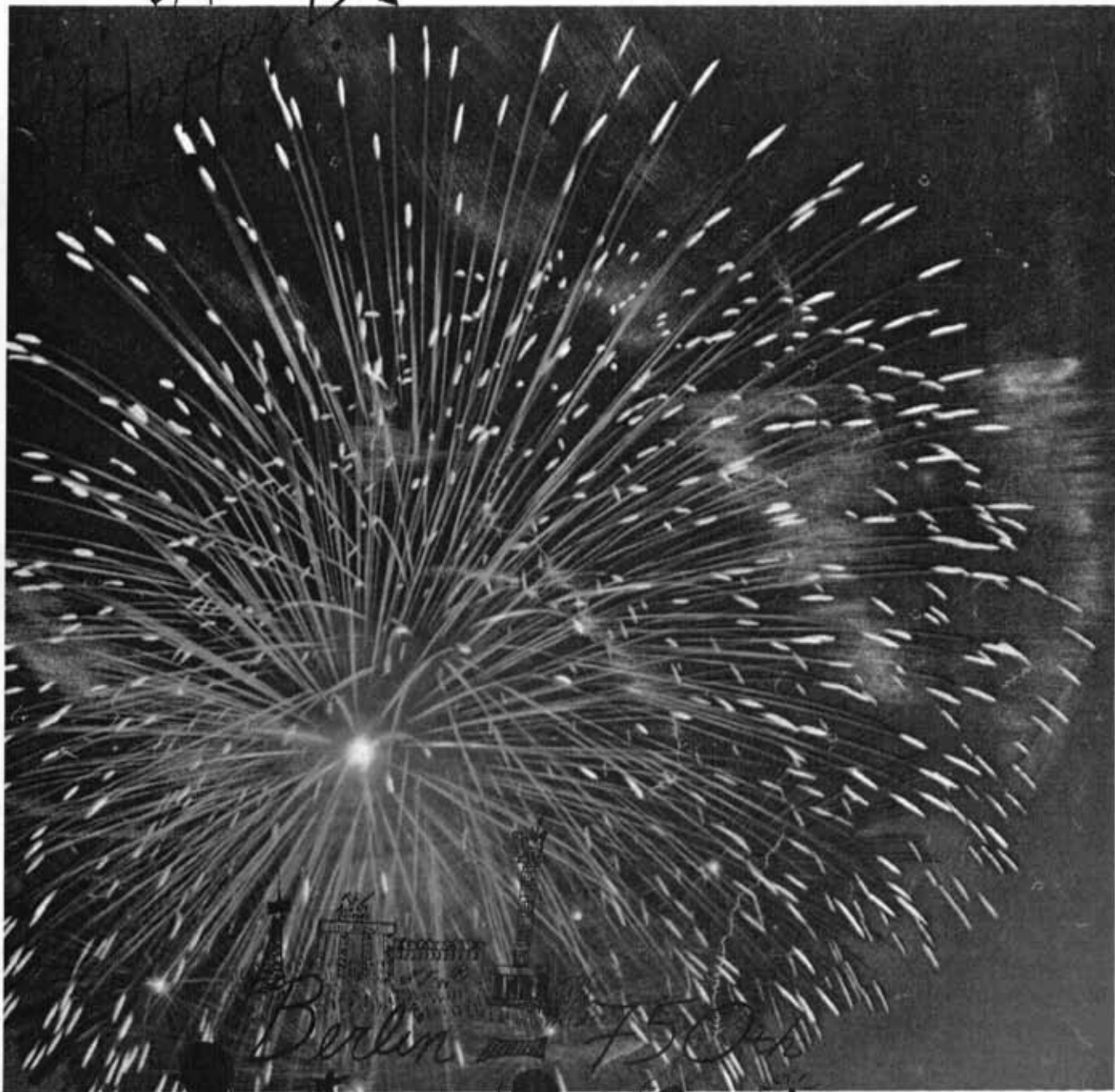

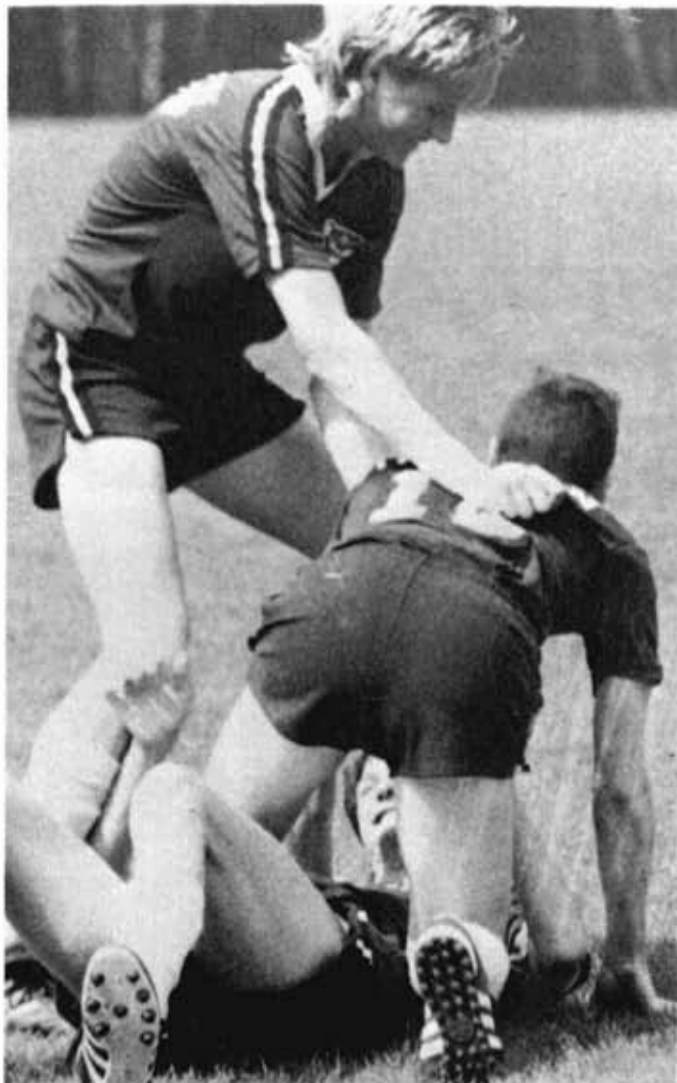

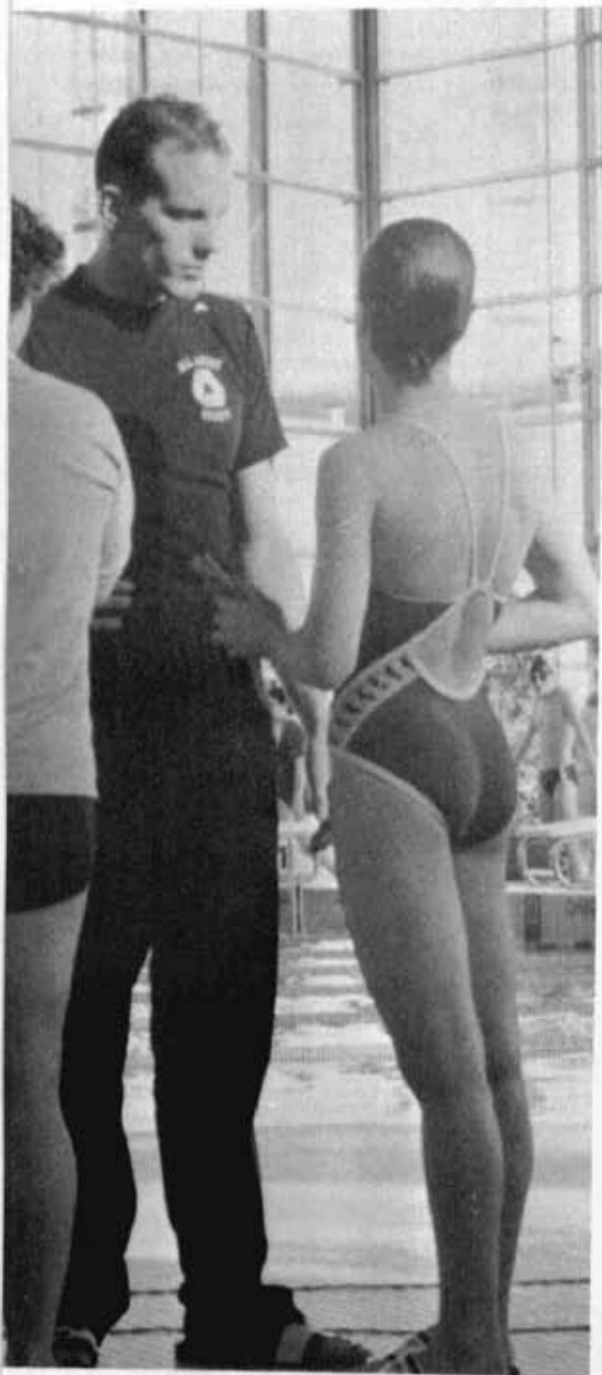
Although Berlin did not win the single A Championships, Mr. Schmoll did lead the Bears to be the North German Champions his call to "Garbage."

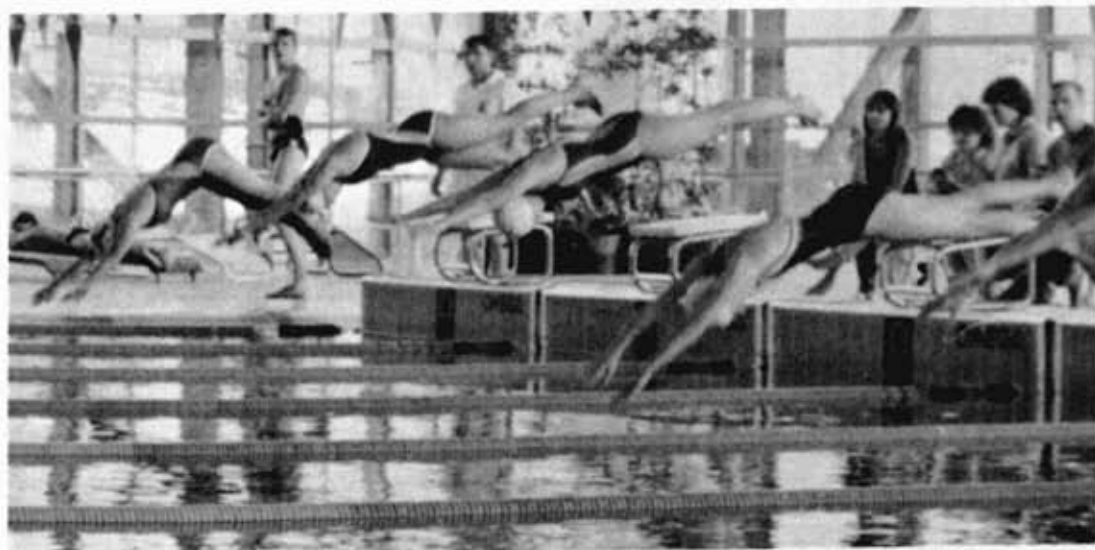
