SCHÖNEBERGER RATHAUS

The cornerstone for the Schöneberger Rathaus was placed at 12 noon on May 26, 1911. The building was occupied in 1914 as the Rathaus for the city of Schöneberg and this use continued until World War II.

During World War II, parts of the Rathaus were destroyed. In April, 1945, the Red Army occupied the Rathaus and by the summer of 1946, the reconstruction was finished. This room, the Plenarsaal, was used for theater, operettas and concerts. Before the division of the city of Berlin, it was also used for the meetings of the Commandantura.

At the time of the division of Berlin, it was decided by Professor Doctor Otto Suhr and the governing mayor of Berlin, Ernst Reuter, that the Rathaus would be used for meetings of the Berlin City Parliament. The first meeting was January, 1949, and in June, 1949, liaison officers of the Allied Forces moved into the Rathaus. The Allied Forces were tenants for the next forty years. In 1950, the Freedom Bell, donated by the people of America, rang for the first time.

The Schöneberger Rathaus, always a center of politics, was the site in 1961 where 500,000 Berliners protested the construction of the Berlin Wall. On June 26, 1963, John F. Kennedy made his famous "Ich bin ein Berliner" speech to a crowd gathered outside the Rathaus. After Kennedy's assassination the square was renamed John F. Kennedy Platz.

Since the opening of the Berlin Wall and the reunification of the city and nation, the Rathaus is used for special occasions, such as the exhibition in honor of Willy Brandt, art exhibitions and Graduation of the Berlin American High School, Class of 1994.
