

1 ANNCR: (GOLD) Hey, gang! It's your Teen Canteen on the Air!

2 MUSIC: OPENING THEME IN FULL, THEN TO BG FOR

3 ANNCR: That's right, gang...this is your Teen Canteen on the Air!

4 But don't you grown-ups go away! Stay right where you are,

5 to hear what's going on at TAR High School, and the things

6 that are of prime interest to teen-agers in town this week.

7 You'll hear one of your favorite songs, the story of what the

8 kids have been doing...and a few surprises. So stay right

9 there by your loudspeakers for the next fifteen minutes...

10 'cause the Teen Canteen is on the Air!

11 MUSIC: UP FULL, THEN TO OUT UNDER

12 ANN: Hi, kids. This is Ann Werrell, back again to bring you the

13 run-down on what you'll be hearing on this week's program.

14 We have a lot of things to take care of this week, so let's

15 get on with them. First of all, through, let's introduce

16 the other kids who make the program possible. C'mon in

17 here and say hello, kids....

18 NANCY: This is Nancy Deens. I've got the story of the things the

19 kids have been doing this last week during vacation.

20 SKIP: ...And this is Skippy Babbitt. Ann tells me that I've got

21 a big job lined up for today. But more about that later.

22 ANN: Right, Skippy. We'll hold off on your end of operations for

23 just a few minutes more.

24 NANCY: We'd better give our listeners a clue as to what's going on,

25 though, Ann.

26 ANN: Well...all right. We've been real lucky this week, kids.

1 ANN: (CONT'D) An old friend of yours -- and ours -- is in Berlin  
2 this week. He's working down in the Zone right now, but he  
3 was good enough to come over to the studios this morning to  
4 tell us about college back in the states. He's had a taste  
5 of it, and he'll try to give us a few pointers about it later  
6 in the show.

7 SKIPPY: I guess that's my job, huh?

8 ANN: That's the main idea, Skippy. (PAUSE) But while you're getting  
9 your questions together, let's swing right into our top song  
10 of the week. Every week at TAR, we try to get around to all  
11 the kids and find out what their favorite song is. Then we  
12 compile the list, and pick the top tune in Berlin this week,  
13 according to the teen-agers we talk to. And here's the song  
14 you picked this week....it's Cubera's You House  
15 and Robert & Lewis songs it for us.

16 MUSIC: TOP TUNE

17 ANN: And now, from the tops in music, let's turn the spotlight on  
18 our guest for the week. We told you a little about him before.  
19 Here he is....Bill Thompson!

20 BILL: Thanks a lot, Ann. Gosh, I don't think I rate all this  
21 classy introducing!

22 ANN: We'll leave that up to our listeners, Bill. I think you've  
23 told us a lot of things we wanted to know about college life  
24 back in the states. Now, we want you to tell the people in  
25 our radio audience about it.

26 BILL: It's kind of tough to get started.

1 SKIP: Then I guess I'd better slide in here and start my end of  
2 things. Suppose I ask you some questions that a lot of us  
3 would like answered?

4 BILL: Well, that would make things a lot easier, Skippy. Fire away!

5 SKIP: Well, to start off...let's find out a little more about you.  
6 When did you go to school here in Berlin last?

7 BILL:

8 SKIP: And then you went to school in the states. What college did  
9 choose?

11 SKIP: Was there any particular reason for this college? I mean...  
12 did it have any special courses that you wanted to take?

13 BILL:

14 SKIP: Fine, Bill. Now, let's get on with our more direct questions.

15 BILL: I just hope I can answer them, though. Remember, I just  
16 went to Purdue. Whatever answers I give are based on my life  
17 there. The same things might now apply at all colleges.

18 SKIP: Okay, Bill. One thing the kids have been wondering about is  
19 how crowded the colleges and universities are. Can you get a  
20 room now?

21 BILL:

22 SKIP: Well, that's one down. Now, about the classes. What courses  
23 in particular do you have to take?

24 BILL:

25 SKIP: Gee, from the way you talk, you don't have much time to go  
26 shopping and things. But that's another question. A lot of

1 SKIP: (CONT'D) our parents are worried about the cost of a college  
2 education. How do you feel about it, Bill? I mean...do you  
3 have to spend a lot of money on books and clothes and things?  
4 BILL:  
5 SKIP: And now to the sixty-four dollar question...which is, what  
6 about the social life? What do college people do that we  
7 don't do here, while we're in high school? Do you have a  
8 lot of dances? And....  
9 BILL: (INTERRUPTING) Easy, Skippy...one thing at a time. First  
10 of all, etc.....  
11 SKIP: Well, it looks like you've sold us, Bill. And thanks a lot  
12 for the information.  
13 BILL: That's okay, Skippy. I just hope it was enough. I'm not the  
14 one to make a lot of blank statements about all colleges, though.  
15 I only went to one!  
16 NANCY: Well, I'm sold!  
17 ANN: Same here, Bill.  
18 SKIP: Easy, girls...he's still mine. Bill...what are you going to  
19 do now? do mean...how long are you going to be in town?  
20 BILL:  
21 SKIP: Swell. And we sure want to thank you for letting us talk to  
22 you this morning.  
23 BILL: It's been a lot of fun, Skippy. I just want to thank <sup>you,</sup> Ann and  
24 ~~Nancy, too, for being so swell.~~ *for asking me up.*  
25 ANN: That's swell, Bill. We'll be seeing you again, won't we?  
26 BILL: I hope so. I'll try to get back real soon.


1 NANCY: Well, we'll be looking for you. So long, Bill.

2 BILL: 'Bye, kids.

3 SKIP: 'Bye, Bill.

4 ANN: Well, with Bill gone, we still have some more time to do  
5 things this morning, so let's go out on a limb again, and play  
6 one of the new records from the AFN-Berlin library that we  
7 think will be a big hit real soon.

8 NANCY: What do you have in mind this week, Ann?

9 ANN: Well, I think this one is pretty good. We'll be waiting for  
10 all of you to request it on the record shows here. It's \_\_\_\_\_  
11 *Louie Gordon*  
~~Please don't leave me~~, with a new song called \_\_\_\_\_.  
12 *Please Don't Leave Me!*  
Mr Engineer, ..music, if you please! 

13 MUSIC: OUT-ON-A-LIMB SPECIAL

14 ANN: That's that. Now, Nancy...what about the story of what's  
15 been happening around school this week?

16 NANCY: What school? Whis is vacation time in Berlin! But lots of  
17 things have been popping anyway. For instance....(READS  
18 SCOOP THRU) And that's it this week, kids. We'll have  
19 more for you next Saturday morning!

20 MUSIC: THEME IN FULL TO BREAK, THEN DOWN TO BG FOR

21 ANN: Well, that's it for this week, gang. We hope you'll keep  
22 writing to us and telling us what you want to hear on the  
23 show. It's your program...for you and about you. (PAUSE)  
24 We'll see you all next Saturday at eleven. Make it a date  
25 for then, when the Teen Canteen is on the Air!
