20 JIM: What do you have in mind, Ann?

21 ANN: Well, there've been a lot of fine recordings coming
22 in to the AFN-Berlin library this last week, haven't
23 there?

24 JIM: You bet there have...and we've selected some of them
25 to be played this morning.

26 SKIP: Hey...how about playing 'Cry'...huh...huh... 'Cry'...huh?

7 off a piece of whole wheat toast....

8 ANN: Huhn-uh! None of that stuff for this gal! I think we'd
9 better wait for Nancy Leone to get well and come back
10 to give us a hand!

11 JIM: Well, I'm only trying to be helpful.

12 SKIP: I know you are...and I appreciate it!

13 ANN: Thank you and good-night, Skippy Babbitt!

14 JIM: Well, if you don't like the sound effects, how about
15 some more of that music?

16 ANN: (SIGHS) Well....I guess we'll have to. What do you
17 recommend, Jim?

18 JIM: I'm sort of partial to this one. See how you like it.
19 Clint.....

20 MUSIC: Got Her on my Hands

21 ANN: That's okay. What's the name of it?

22 JIM: Got Her on my Hands by Paul Robeson
23 It has a pretty good chance of making the Hit Parade, I
24 think.

25 SKIP: Hey, Jim...is that clock right?

26 JIM: It ought to be. I just set it before we came into the
studio....why?

1 SKIP: Well, according to it, we still have time to hear
2 another one of those new songs. How about playing
3 that one by Ray Henry? Huh...
4 huh....how about it, huh?

5 JIM: Well, it's up to Ann. What say, gal?

6 ANN: Well....all right.

7 JIM: Okay, then...here's Buzman's Shippy

8 MUSIC:

9 JIM: Well, kids...looks like that just about wraps it up for
10 this week. Any closing remarks?

11 ANN: I'd just like to say that we sure hope Nancy Leone will
12 be back with us real soon. We sure do miss her.

13 SKIP: Same here. Bye now, gang!

14 MUSIC: CLOSING THEME IN FULL. THEN DOWN FOR

15 ANN: Well, that's it for another show, kids. This is Ann
16 Worrell, speaking for Skippy Babbitt, Sergeant Jim
17 Stratton, and the man in the control room -- Corporal
18 Clint Ramey -- inviting you to be back with us again
19 next Saturday morning at this time, when the Teen Canteen
20 is on the Air!
