

Cubs, Barons Divide in Red League Action

BERLIN (Special)—The Berlin Cubs and the Bitburg Barons divided a two-game series here Friday and Saturday with each club posting a four-point victory in Red Division play.

A three-point play in the last minute of play by Cleo Johnson enabled Berlin to register a 44-40 triumph and hand Bitburg its first loss of the season.

In the second game, Larry Bolster hit for 17 points to give Bitburg a 34-30 victory.

Leading 40-39 in the first game, Bitburg went into a stall with 1:30 left. But Berlin stole the ball and Johnson drove in for a bucket and was fouled. He sank the free throw and later added two more charity tosses to ice the game.

Johnson was the top scorer in the first game with 21 points. Teammate Bob O'Neill had 10. Larry Bolster scored 15 for the Barons.

The junior varsity games were also split, Bitburg winning the first game, 31-22, and Berlin the second game, 25-15.
