#### COACH

Practice begins with only four or five holdovers from the previous season. In three weeks the "T", "ProSet" and "Single Wing" offensive formations must be introduced and a hard, charging, workable defense established. In addition, an assistant coach who will dedicate himself to the same high ideals as the head coach must be found.

All these and many more problems faced Mr. George W. Pepoy as each of the past five BAHS football seasons got under way. It was not an easy task, and it was one that might discourage many coaches. Coach Pepoy accepted each year as a new challenge. Despite many handicaps, he compiled an excellent 29-6 record. This record included two Silver Division Championships and brought Coach Pepoy recognition as one of the finest American High School coaches in Europe.

Beyond a coaching record, perhaps the greatest honor which can be paid to any coach is the respect he receives from his players, the students, his colleagues in the coaching fraternity, and the community in which he resides. Coach Pepoy has this respect because he devotes himself to fair play. Both on and off the field, his actions and his deeds attest to this. The time and effort which he has given to the BAHS sport programs, and to building not only ballplayers but their characters as well, will long be remembered and cherished by those young men who have had the honor to play for him.
