- 1 ANNCR: (COLD) Hey, gang! It's your Teen Canteen on the Air!
- 2 MUSIC: THEME IN FULL, THEN TO BG FOR
- 3 JIM: That's right, gang! It's your Teen Canteen on the Air, with  
4 fifteen minutes of fun for everyone. Every Saturday morning  
5 at this time, your teen-age mistresses of ceremonies will be  
6 here to present a quarter-hour of comedy and music, together  
7 with a few surprises. You'll learn what the trends are among  
8 the teen-agers in Berlin. So stay with us now...for the Teen  
9 Canteen is on the Air!
- 10 MUSIC: UP FULL TO BREAK, THEN TO OUT UNDER
- 11 JIM: And now, here's the gal who makes the official introductions  
12 around these parts...Ann Worrell!
- 13 ANN: Thanks, Jimmy, and hi there, gang!
- 14 JIM: You sure look fine this morning, Ann. But say...where is  
15 everybody?
- 16 ANN: Well, Skippy Babbitt's here. Skippy! Come on over here!
- 17 SKIP: Sure thing. What's up, Ann?
- 18 ANN: Well, Jimmy was just asking where everyone was this morning.
- 19 SKIP: We're here. What more do you need?
- 20 JIM: Ya wants know? (PAUSE) No...seriously, I was wondering where  
21 Nancy is.
- 22 ANN: She had to go out of town for a few days. But she'll be with  
23 us next week...we hope.
- 24 JIM: Well, that leaves it up to you gals, and old Judge Ramey,  
25 over there in the control room.
- 26 SKIP: Hey, Jim...how 'bout some music? huh -- huh -- some music -- huh?

1 JIM: Good deal, Skippy. I'll leave it up to Clint. What say, old  
2 man? Got something cued up for us? (PAUSE) Yes? (PAUSE)  
3 He nods yes. What is it? (PAUSE) The national anthem? (LAUGHS)  
4 Oh, no! This I've got to hear!

5 MUSIC: P-2143-1 Dixie Jump IN FULL TO END

6 JIM: I get it now....that was the confederate national anthem. Only  
7 in this case....the Dixie Jump by Ralph Flanagan's orchestra.

8 ANN: What's this thing you were telling us about before we went on  
9 the air, Jim?

10 JIM: Oh, you mean the special deal?

11 ANN: That's it.

12 JIM: Well, we've done some research, and we find that just about  
13 everyone we've run into is happy with his Army job. We haven't  
14 heard anyone complain about a thing. (ASIDE) By the way, I  
15 wrote this script with a crayon. They won't let me have anything  
16 sharp in here. (PAUSE) But anyway, we know that because all  
17 of the draftees, especially are meeting the challenge of the  
18 Army life, and are bearing up under it so well, that they'll  
19 probably get a big charge out of hearing our special skit this  
20 morning.

21 SKIP: What's it about, Jim?

22 JIM: It's about war, gals...real war. We're going to take a trip  
23 to the Henry Morgan theater of coming attractions to see a  
24 new motion picture...or at least, the coming attractions. They're  
25 better. Then you can see what the picture's about, without  
26 having to sit through the whole show. It goes like this.....
