SUBJECT: 1952 DSD Basketball Tournaments



Regional Superintendents

- 1. The 1952 EUCON High School Basketball Tournament will be held in the Betts area Gymnasium, Frankfurt Military Post on Friday and Saturday, 14 15 March 1952. The tournament will consist of 14 games. The admission price will be 50 cents per day, or fraction thereof. There will be 8 games on Friday and 6 games on Saturday. The first game will begin at 0900 on Friday and the final championship game will begin at 1630 on Saturday. Mr. Herman D. Search, Regional Superintendent of Frankfurt, will serve as Tournament Manager.
- 2. Frankfurt Military Post will make arrangements for messing, billeting, and local transportation for each visiting squad. Each squad will consist of a maximum of 12 members, a student manager, and the coach. Billets will be provided Friday night, 14 March, only, unless special arrangements are made with Mr. Search prior to 1700 hours, 5 March. Mr. Search must be notified of the expected arrival time of all squads prior to the same date, 5 March. All participents will pay for their own meals. Members of squads will be admitted free to all sessions upon the presentation of their FLAYER TICKETS. These must be presented each time the player enters the gymnasium.
 - 3. Each school will be allowed a maximum of 5 cheerleaders and one faculty sponsor. Billet arrangements for the cheerleaders will be made by the principal of the Frankfurt High School at individual homes. All schools must secure their own orders for the basketball squad, cheerleaders and the faculty sponsor from local posts. Orders for all EUCOL coaches will be issued by DSD Headquarters and will be the only personnel authorized per diem.
 - 4. The Frankfurt l'ilitary lost cannot provide billeting facilities for spectators due to the great influx of dependents during the past few weeks. A limited number of spectators from Berlin, Bremerhaven, Linz, Lunich and Nuernberg may make individual arrangements with private families for billeting. Principals should check on the authenticity of these private arrangements to determine if they are really valid. Frankfurt Lilitary lost assumes no responsibility for the local transportation, messing or billeting of spectators making these private arrangements.

It must be understood that neither the teachers nor the parents chaperoning the regular groups will be responsible for these spectators while traveling on the train. It must also be understood that the teachers accompaning the regular groups will not be able to supervise the activities of the spectators who make private billeting arrangements while they are in Frankfurt. Parents must be so informed.

6. Inclosure #1 is the plan of the Tournament which indicates how the drawings are to be made. Drawings will be held at DSD headquarters as soon as conference standings are determined and all school will be notified by Mr. Search.

7. The contents of this letter will immediately be circulated in writing to parents of all children in grades 9 - 12 so that they will be fully aware of the responsibilities of the players and spectators.
